WHAT?

Archipelago Center Korpoström welcomes you with its delicious restaurant food and comfortable hotel rooms.

After a good night's sleep and a hearty breakfast, we get ready for a sailing adventure among scenic islands in the unique Archipelago Sea biosphere area. We steer towards a beautiful archipelago island with the traditional brick-built Storbåt Tacksamheten. The boat sails with minimal carbon footprint and environmental impact. When we arrive on the island, we enjoy a good lunch made from local ingredients. After this, it's time to roll up your sleeves and participate in the nature conservation work on the island followed by a guided tour.

With a good spirit from the volunary work, we start the journey back with Tacksamheten towards the Archipelago Center Korpoström where the heated sauna awaits. The day ends with a delicious dinner made with local meat looking out over the guest harbor with incoming and outgoing leisure boats.







WHERE?

On the beautiful archipelago island Korpo in the archipelago of Turku, about 80 km from Turku. You can get here easily by car, bus or bicycle Korpo is well connected to the mainland via two ferries that are free and operate around the clock, all year round. During the summer with about 15 min. intervals, in winter slightly less frequently.
